



Ana Zatezalo Schenk received an Architecture Degree from Ecoled'Architecture Paris-Villemin in 1999 and a Master of Architecture from Columbia University in 2001. Presently Ana is finalizing her MBA thesis from HEC, Paris.

Since 2001, Ana develops in New York and in Paris, projects combining research and design in the fields of architecture, landscape design and urban planning. Ana has worked in various offices Technip Serie Construction and Architecture Studio in Paris, Zaha Hadid in London and Archi-Tectonics and Evan Dougllis in New York.

In 2004 Ana sets her own practice in Belgrade, after receiving a commission to build a Design Hotel in the center of Belgrade facing the Royal Palace and the Parliament. Since then Sinestezia is developing a diverse portfolio of regional and international projects.

From 2007 Ana Zatezalo Schenk leads a developers project on 100 ha land site located at the Danube River, from visioning, through pre feasibility up to phasing and communication with city institutions, investors etc. She is a single point of contact for coordinating design/development with third party consultants, contractors, investors, governmental agencies, and acts as liaison between internal and external cross-functional teams, global design & construction, and corporate service/global real estate leadership teams.

Her work has been published and exhibited in shows at the Venice Biennale, UIA Istanbul, Beijing Architecture Biennale, MIPIM in Cannes etc. Zatezalo Schenk taught architectural design studios and Workshops in the USA, in France, and in Serbia.
